Using the simplest drawing materials—ink on paper—

Lewis created a complex image. His variation of vertical lines, the density of ink, the size of marks, and the amount of smudging all contribute to a composition that pulsates with energy. Lewis adapted the language of sound—"echoes"— for this image, and the rhythmic pattern has a visual beat, like an improvised line of jazz music.
